## Major Actions Taken by the Districts during the Preceding Year

1. Capital fund expenditures of the Headwaters Metropolitan District in 2013:

Please note the costs reflected above for the Districts' 2013 infrastructure projects are preliminary year end amounts. 2. Other major actions undertaken by the Districts during 2013 include the ongoing lease of the ski mountain and golf course as well as operation and maintenance of the roads within the Districts.

The ski area (Ski Granby Ranch) and the golf course (Golf Granby Ranch) are leased by Headwaters Metro from the Developer of the community. In December 2012 Headwaters Metropolitan District entered into a Second Amended Lease Purchase Agreement with Granby Realty Holdings, LLC and also a Leased Premises Management Agreement with Granby Ranch Amenities, LLC.
